CALL FOR PAPERS:

Immune Deficiency, Dysregulation, and Cancer

The *Journal of Immunotherapy and Precision Oncology (JIPO)* is seeking submissions for an upcoming issue special issue devoted to “Immune Deficiency, Dysregulation, and Cancer.” The issue will include original research, reviews, case reports, and more. Topics for consideration are listed below.

Topics for Consideration Include:

- Incidence, prognosis, and treatment outcomes in patients with primary or secondary immune system deficiency (i.e., post-transplant or HIV)
- Immune-related toxicity in patients with immune system dysregulations treated with immunotherapeutic agents
- Clinical trials of immune system deficiency that include patients with cancer
- Biomarkers for immune system monitoring during immunotherapy (IO)
 - Autoimmune disease and immunotherapy, including safety of IO in patients w Lupus, AR, or psoriasis and histopathological similarities and differences
- Other compelling cancer-IO related studies

To be considered for the special issue, manuscripts must be submitted by May 31, 2019.
